Sunday 14th August

Visit the SS Freshspring situated on Bideford Quay

We have been invited to visit the Ship and learn about her history and restoration and display our Classics in the Overflow car park across from the Ship.

SS Freshspring is the only surviving example of the 14 Fresh class water carriers built by Lytham Shipbuilding and Engineering Co for the Royal Fleet Auxiliary (RFA). Built in 1946, she was the last of 14 Fresh Class water carriers, all of which were 121 feet in length. Her duty was to replenish Naval ships with fresh water for use in boilers. She also acted as a fire tender and salvage vessel when required. She returned to the UK in 1967 to replace a sister ship, Freshpond, at Devonport.



Prior to being put into reserve in 1976 at Gareloch, she also worked in and around the Clyde and Pembroke docks and she was surveyed and refitted at Ardrossan in 1969.

Tea and Coffee is provided and a seating area on Board if you chose to bring a picnic.

Entry Fee of just £2.50 per person, payable on entry and car parking is free.

Arrive from 10am and leave when you are ready.





The event is a great day out and it is not often you can see classics tearing up the track, get close to the action in the pits and all at a reasonable price and within striking distance of North Devon. This is a watching event rather than a taking part event although there is usually an opportunity to take to the track for a slow meander round if booked in advance.



Tyres & How to Date Them

With tyres and their age hitting the news recently, I thought it worth rerunning this article on tyres, first published in August 2019.

The guide to Tyre Dating produced by Vintage Tyres www.vintagetyres.com. With a lot of our cars doing low mileage and some are exempt from the MoT, check yours as they may be well past their best despite having lots of tread left!

From 2000 to present day

The date code is four digits long. The first two digits represent the week of production, and the second two represent the year. The tyre in the picture was made in the thirteenth week of 2011.



Between 1990-1999

The date code is three digits long. For the Nineties this was followed by a triangle. The first two digits represent the week of production, the third digit represents the year. The tyre in the picture was made in the first week of 1996 (note the small triangle on the right)



Between 1980-1989.

The three-digit code was also used in the Eighties, but without the triangle. The format is otherwise exactly the same as the later system. So, the tyre in the picture was made in the seventh week of 1981.



Pre 1980

If your tyre doesn't have any of the markings above, it was made before 1980 and should be replaced as a matter of course.

2002 BMW Z3 2.2 M-Sport Roadster manual for sale.

My final edition Sport roadster, registered in April 2002 is reluctantly offered for sale. I have owned it for four years which is the longest I have ever owned a car but it's now time for a change. It has always been garaged and run on super unleaded petrol during my ownership. The MOT runs until August 2022 and there were no advisories. A new MOT will be arranged for the purchaser.

It was ordered in an individual colour and interior specification of Aegean blue metallic (code 336) with lotus white leather upholstery (code 0226). This would appear to be a rare combination as I have not seen another Z3 in these colours.

As a Sport edition, it has a limited slip differential, M Sport suspension, M steering wheel and model specific velour mats. Heated and electrically operated sports seats and cold air conditioning complete the specification.

I have maintained the car to ensure that it is in excellent order for a twenty year old vehicle. New Toyo Proxes were fitted all round two years ago and the fuel tank straps were replaced in December 2020. This is a common problem on the Z3 and was an advisory notice in an earlier MOT. I had an Inspection 1 service carried out with a brake fluid change in March 2021 at 69,112 miles and oil and filter change was performed on 30 March this year at 70,375. The bonnet has been repainted to remove various stone chips and age related marks.

The electric hood operates smoothly and has been regularly re-proofed. A bespoke Perspex Z3 wind deflector has also been fitted.

The mileage is currently 70,420 but this will increase as the car is in regular use.

The soft top cover, handbooks and all keys are present.

Now priced at £6,250.




